

Arguments

Good arguments are logical and relevant to the point An argument shoulld be made up of:

- ► ASSERTION: what you are trying to prove
- ► REASONING: the reason why the assertion is logical
- ► EVIDENCE: examples or data that support the assertion and the reasoning



Ajudicators


An adjudicator must:

- ▶ Not be influenced by their knoledge
- ▶ Not be influenced by their personal beliefs
- Not interpret what they think the debater is trying to say

TOPICS

- Cell-phones should be prohibited during classes (Model 1)

- Soft drugs should be legalized or
